

CHAPTER X. POLICE DEPARTMENT

Article 1. General Provisions

ARTICLE 1. GENERAL PROVISIONS

10-101. POLICE DEPARTMENT. The police department of this city shall consist of a chief of police and such number of regular police officers as shall be appointed as provided by K.S.A. 15-204 and amendments thereto. (Code 1986)

10-102. POLICE PERSONNEL; GENERAL DUTIES. It shall be the general duty of the chief of police and all sworn police personnel to the best of their ability to preserve good order, peace and quiet throughout the city as provided by law or ordinance.

The chief of police and all sworn police personnel shall at all times have power to make arrest under proper process or without process on view of any offense against the laws of the State of Kansas or ordinances of the city and to keep all persons so arrested, unless admitted to bail, in the city jail, county jail or other proper place to prevent their escape until their trial can be had before the proper officer. 10-103. RULES AND REGULATIONS. The chief of police shall have power to make such rules and regulations as may be necessary for the proper and efficient conduct of the department. (Code 1986)
