

**April 4, 2011
City Council Meeting
Regular Council Meeting**

The regular council meeting for the City of Cimarron convened April 4, 2011 at 7:32 p.m. at the regular meeting place and was called to order by Mayor John Rohrbaugh. The following councilmembers were present: Darrell Dupree, Alan Riney, Orris Franzitta, Jeff Monical and Sandy Pickle . Employees present: Randall Cummins, Patty Duncan, and Mike Doll. Guests that were present were Candi Hemel, Max Birney, Nathan Moore, Todd Siek and Joel Krosschell.

Max Birney and Nathan Moore paid the City for the purchase of the airport and the leasing of property that was agreed upon.

Motion was made by councilmember Alan Riney and seconded by councilmember Orris Franzitta to accept the consent agenda. All in favor. Motion carried.

Motion was made by councilmember Orris Franzitta and seconded by councilmember Darrel Dupree to accept the application for neighborhood revitalization from Doug and Carrie Althouse and to forward to the county treasurer for processing. All in favor. Motion carried.

Joel Krosschell discussed the bids for the Bainter Addition. The streets bids will open April 14 at 3:00 p.m. Motion was made by councilmember Jeff Monical and seconded by councilmember Sandy Pickle to accept the low bid of \$134,954.75 from Dick Construction for the construction on the water and sewer. All in favor. Motion carried.

Todd Siek discussed new personnel. Motion was made by Alan Riney and seconded by councilmember Orris Franzitta to accept Craig Stockhaus as a full time employee for the golf course subject to all benefits for full time employment. All in favor. Motion carried.

Todd Siek discussed the building of a 32 golf cart shed at the golf course. The golf course wants to have local companies place bids for the construction. The golf course was needing the approval of the city to get the loan for the project. The city will support the golf course.

Liability insurance at the airport was discussed . Motion was made by councilmember Jeff Monical and seconded by councilmember Darrell Dupree to increase the liability insurance to \$1,000,000.00 combined single limit for bodily injury and property damage per occurrence and \$2,000,000.00 aggregate for the premium of \$2,450.00 a year. All in favor. Motion carried.

Gray County Historical Society requested \$500.00 from the city to help fulfill a grant they received. Motion was made by councilmember Darrell Dupree and seconded by councilmember Sandy Pickle to donate the \$500.00 requested. All in favor. Motion carried.

There will be a meeting with the county commissioners and the city council to discuss the law enforcement contract on April 12, 2011 at 5:00 p.m.

Building permits were discussed. Randall Cummins will contact the people and check the property.

Motion was made by councilmember Alan Riney and seconded by councilmember Sandy Pickle to go into executive session at 8:55:p.m. for ten minutes to discuss personnel . All in favor. Motion carried.
