

**February 7, 2011  
City Council Meeting  
Regular Council Meeting**

The regular council meeting for the City of Cimarron convened February 7, 2011 at 7:40 p.m. at the regular meeting place and was called to order by Mayor John Rohrbaugh. The following councilmembers were present: Darrell Dupree, Alan Riney, Orris Franzitta, and Sandy Pickle . Employees present: Dennis Rohrbaugh, Patty Duncan, Mike Doll. Guests that were present were Wes Bainter, Mark Detter, Joel Krosschell.

Mark Detter discussed the bonding issues for the Bainter Addition. Temporary notes will be issued for six months to one year with permanent bonds after a year. Motion was made by councilmember Sandy Pickle and seconded by Darrell Dupree to participate in the underwriting agreement . All in favor. Motion carried.

Discussion was held on the need for a letter of credit from Wes Bainter It was decided that no letter of credit would be needed.

Motion was made by councilmember Orris Franzitta and seconded by councilmember Sandy Pickle to approve the Resolution 271 "A resolution determining the advisability of the making of certain internal improvements in the city of Cimarron; Making certain findings with respect thereto; and authorizing and providing for the making of the improvements in accordance with such findings (street/sewer/water improvements/Bainter addition)". All in favor. Motion carried.

The railroad crossing to the lagoons was discussed. More information is needed before a decision is made. Dennis Rohrbaugh to make the contacts required . This matter to be on the March council meeting agenda.

The recreational trails project is to be resubmitted again this year.

Test results from the airport were partially back three of the four holes tested good. Waiting for the results on hole two.

Discussion was held on the need for a new mosquito fogger. The bids were discussed. Motion by councilmember Orris Franzitta and seconded by councilmember Darrell Dupree was made to accept the \$9423.12 bid from Van Diest Supply Company

Well #5 was discussed. A motion was made by councilmember Alan Riney and seconded by Orris Franzitta to purchase a submersible pump in the amount of \$15,202.96 to increase the productivity of this well. All in favor. Motion carried.

Dennis Rohrbaugh is to check on finding a generator for emergency purposes for a water well to be able to run in case of a power outage.

Pool Heater was tabled until further information is received.

Discussion was held on the tornado sirens and decided that it is the county's responsibility and emergency services.

Celeste Lacy will be the swimming pool manager again this year.

Bids for a new copier was discussed. A motion was made by councilmember Darrell Dupree and seconded by councilmember Sandy Pickle to accept the bid \$3,799.00 from Office Solutions for a Sharp MX-B402. All in favor. Motion carried.

Motion made by councilmember Orris Franzitta and seconded by Allen Riney to accept the CMB license for Cancun Mexican Grill.

Motion was made by councilmember Orris Franzitta and seconded by councilmember Sandy Pickle to approve the consent agenda All in favor. Motion carried.

Councilmember Orris Franzitta gave an update on the golf course meeting. The city will check into signs to direct people to the golf course.

Motion was made by councilmember Alan Riney and seconded by councilmember Sandy Pickle to go into executive session at 10:33 p.m. for ten minutes. All in favor. Motion carried. Reconvened at 10:43 p.m. Interviews to be arranged for the lineman position and the part time position.
