

**January 3, 2011
City Council Meeting
Regular Council Meeting**

The regular council meeting for the City of Cimarron convened January 3, 2011 at 7:35 p.m. at the regular meeting place and was called to order by Mayor John Rohrbaugh. The following councilmembers were present: Darrell Dupree, Alan Riney, Orris Franzitta, Sandy Pickle and Jeff Monical. Employees present: Dennis Rohrbaugh, Patty Duncan, Mike Doll. Guest that was present was Candi Hemel.

Motion was by council member Jeff Monical and seconded by councilmember Alan Riney to clarify the transfer of \$35,000.00 from equipment reserve to sewer department. The \$35,000.00 is to be reallocated from electric equipment to the sewer vac truck line in equipment reserve. Funds are then to be transferred from equipment reserve sewer vac truck fund to the sewer department. All in favor. Motion carried.

Motion made by councilmember Alan Riney and seconded by councilmember Sandy Pickle to amend the dog pound Ordinance that is in place. Ordinance Number 997 is an ordinance amending 2-209 of the code of the City of Cimarron relating to the impoundment of dogs.

Net metering options was discussed. Motion to accept option 4 was made by councilmember Darrel Dupree and seconded by Jeff Monical. Ordinance is to be done reflecting option 4. All in favor. Motion Carried.

The transient guest tax was discussed. Further information needs to be obtained. No decision made.

Motion made by councilmember Orris Franzitta and seconded by councilmember Sandy Pickle at 8:27 p.m. to go into executive session for 10 minutes to discuss personnel. All in favor. Motion carried. Reconvened at 8:37 p.m. No action taken.

Motion made by councilmember Darrell Dupree and seconded by councilmember Alan Riney to go with CINTAS for uniforms. All in favor. Motion carried.

Well #5 was discussed. Dennis Rohrbaugh to put together numbers and be put on the February agenda.

Copier and computers for the office was discussed. More information was needed for the copier. It was the consensus of the council to proceed with getting one new computer capable of doing the work required.
