

**March 7, 2011
City Council Meeting
Regular Council Meeting**

The regular council meeting for the City of Cimarron convened March 7, 2011 at 7:38 p.m. at the regular meeting place and was called to order by Mayor John Rohrbaugh. The following councilmembers were present: Darrell Dupree, Alan Riney, Orris Franzitta, Jeff Monical and Sandy Pickle . Employees present: Dennis Rohrbaugh, Patty Duncan, and Randall Cummins, Mike Doll. Guests that were present were Candi Hemel, Jeff Sharp, Nathan Moore, Marcus Rogge, and boy scout troop 148 Alex Pfeifer, Chuck Pfeifer, Jack Berry, Paden Bergdall, Nick Franzitta.

Marcus Rogge and Nathan Moore discussed the buying or leasing of the buildings and improvements at the airport. No decision made at this time.

Candi Hemel recommended Scott Feldt, Matt Monical and Gerald Vogel to be on the library board. Motion was made by councilmember Alan Riney and seconded by councilmember Jeff Monical to accept the recommendation of Candi Hemel and appointments were made. All in favor. Motion carried.

Vacating alley between Gilbert Benton and Doug Althouse was discussed. Attorney Mike Doll to draw up paperwork.

Mike Renick utility easement was done. Dennis Rohrbaugh to contact Mike Renick for signatures.

Ronald Burns easement was done. Dennis Rohrbaugh to contact Ronald Burns for signatures The railroad crossing to the lagoons was discussed. More information is needed before a decision is made. Dennis Rohrbaugh to make the contacts required . This matter to be on the April council meeting agenda.

Motion was made by councilmember Sandy Pickle and seconded by councilmember Alan Riney that KMEA board of directors will stay the same, John Rohrbaugh and Darrell Dupree . All in favor. Motion carried.

Discussion was held on the Law Enforcement Services Agreement. Undersheriff Jeffery Sharp answered questions. A meeting will be set up with the county commissioners and the city council for further discussion.

Motion was made by councilmember Alan Riney and seconded by councilmember Sandy Pickle to appoint Jae Lee and Darrin Addison to the zoning board.

Motion was made by councilmember Sandy Pickle and seconded by councilmember Orris Franzitta to pay the Library Board the amount of \$10,000.00 that was budgeted for them. All in favor. Motion carried.

Motion was made by councilmember Sandy Pickle and seconded by councilmember Jeff Monical to change the municipal court date to the first Monday of the month at 5:00 p.m. All

in favor. Motion carried. To be published in the local newspaper and sheriff's office to be advised of change.

Discussion was held on the insurance for the city buildings, equipment, vehicles . EMC had suggested changes in several areas to keep up with the replacement costs. Motion was made by councilmember Alan Riney and seconded by councilmember Sandy Pickle. Orris Franzitta opposed. Motion Carried.

Discussion on boarder for the park playground was held. No action taken

Motion was made by councilmember Orris Franzitta and seconded by councilmember Jeff Monical to go into executive session at 9:10 p.m. for five minutes. All in favor. Motion carried. Reconvened at 9:15 p.m.

Motion was made by councilmember Orris Franzitta and seconded by councilmember Jeff Monical to give Sandy Unruh a 5% raise retroactive to January. All in favor. Motion carried.

Motion was made by councilmember Jeff Monical and seconded by councilmember Darrell Dupree to go into executive session at 9:25 p.m. for five minutes. All in favor. Motion carried. Reconvened at 9:30 p.m. No decision made.

Motion was made by councilmember Alan Riney and seconded by councilmember Sandy Pickle to go into executive session at 9:35 p.m. for ten minutes. All in favor. Motion carried. Reconvened at 9:42 p.m

Motion was made by councilmember Sandy Pickle and seconded by councilmember Jeff Monical to give Rick Schiffner a fifty cent an hour raise and after he moves to Cimarron another fifty cents. All in favor. Motion carried.

Discussion was held on the summer recreation director. Motion was made by councilmember Sandy Pickle and seconded by councilmember Jeff Monical to hire Mitchell Ridenour at the wage of \$2,000.00 a month for April May and June. City will do the preparation on the ball fields. All in favor. Motion carried.

Motion was made by councilmember Orris Franzitta and seconded by councilmember Sandy Pickle to accept the resignation of Dennis Rohrbaugh as City Superintendent. All in favor. Motion carried.
