

Special Council Meeting  
May 9, 2011

The Special Council Meeting for the City of Cimarron convened May 9, 2011, at 7:30 p.m. at the regular meeting place and was called to order by Mayor Gilbert Benton. The following councilmembers were present: Alan Riney, Sandy Pickle, Darrell Dupree, Judy Hilker and Tammy Richardson. Employee present was Patty Duncan and Randall Cummins. Guests present were: Joey Duncan, Charles Hoskinson, Bradley Hanson, Jeff Sharp, Matt Meairs and Kirk Anderson .

Discussion was held on the Law Enforcement contract with the county. The contract states that the city would receive reports on the activity in the city by officers. It has not happened but will begin. The council would like changes made to the contract as to the police helping with dog control and the city would like dog at large offenders to be ticketed. And the percentage that the county and the city would share for the fines and costs. Reports to be reviewed monthly and if the council feels the requirements of the contract not being met it will be discussed in July at budget time for a city police department to be started for 2012.
